



YAMAHA STRING CLASS

violin and cello for children from 6 years
(for age groups 6 – 8 / 9 – 10 years)

objective: complete course playing in the orchestra

Contrary to tradition, which provides for the need to individually learn to play a stringed instrument before playing in an orchestra, with THE YAMAHA METHOD the procedure is reversed.

THE ADVANTAGES : a gradual and progressive path that allows even the youngest to learn in an engaging and effective way, first allowing the training of the musical ear, necessary to bring the acquired language onto the instrument, so as to tackle the necessary technique in small steps and always according to musical needs.

THE METHOD : In the first semester the children experiment and play BOTH THE VIOLIN AND THE CELLO, to choose the most suitable for their aptitudes, learning the language through ALL MUSICAL EXPERIENCES: they learn to listen, developing creativity, associating appropriate images with sound; they internalize the language with the help of movement and singing; they play what they have experienced by listening and singing, to then recognise, write and read the music they have experienced; they understand the importance of group work, PLAYING IN THE ORCHESTRA FROM THE 1ST LESSON.

Collective learning in small groups is really effective, because it is dynamic, pleasant and at the same time allows the teacher to carefully take care of the most correct approach to the instrument and the individual needs of each student.

The course is structured in 2 levels, with a two-year course, with 30 group lessons per year (15 per semester), of 60 minutes each, on a weekly basis. It is subject to periodic verification and allows access to individual advanced courses.
